

**Agreement of Academic Cooperation**  
**between**  
**Department of Electrical Engineering, College of Science and Technology,**  
**National Chi Nan University**  
**and**  
**Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering, College of Engineering,**  
**University of Texas at San Antonio**

1. National Chi Nan University of the Republic of China and University of Texas at San Antonio of USA, in order to promote cooperation in academic education and research, enter into the present Agreement between the Department of Electrical Engineering of the National Chi Nan University and the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering, University of Texas at San Antonio, based on the principle of equality and mutual benefit.
2. Both parties agree to develop a comprehensively cooperative relationship on the basis of this Agreement.
3. The extent of cooperation covered by this Agreement includes the following projects:
  - A. The exchange of students and faculties
  - B. Educational and research collaborative activities
4. Details regarding the funding and other conditions for each specific project shall be negotiated by the respective authorities of the two faculties on a case-by-case basis.
5. This Agreement will become effective upon being signed by the authorized representatives of both faculties. The academic cooperation stipulated by this Agreement shall have the duration of five years. At the end of that period, the parties may decide to renew the Agreement for another five years. Should either party decide not to renew the cooperation Agreement, they shall notify the other party in writing within six months of the end of the Agreement. If, at the end of the five years period, neither party has expressly declared its intention to renew the Agreement, the Agreement shall be expired automatically.
6. The present Agreement has been drawn up in English with traditional Chinese translation.
